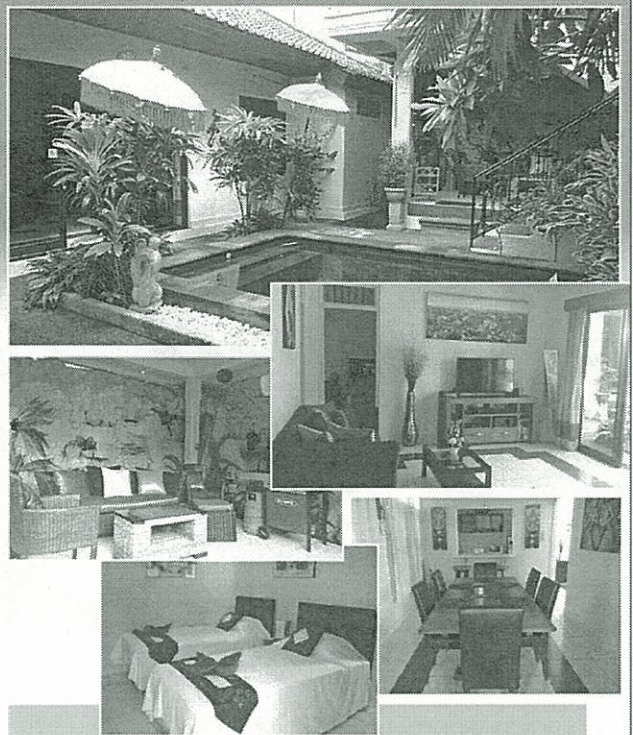


VILLA *Senang*

Samara Is Doing It Again Another fundraising event organized by 15 year old Samara Welbourne

Do you remember the heartbreaking story about the elderly Denpasar Dokar driver not able to feed his horse any more? Do you remember the fundraising event to support him held at the Glass House Restaurant in Sanur by a 15 year old Australian teenager? She is doing it again.

If you have a little (or not so little) fairy lover in your household, bring them to the Trans Resort Bali on Sunday 29 May for an Enchanted Fairy Day.

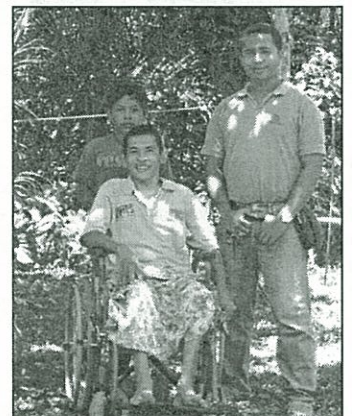
100% of the proceeds from the fairy house classes will go to Puspadi Bali client, single father Darma, paralyzed when he fell from a Jackfruit tree 3 years ago. The money will be used to

buy a motor bike and have it converted for a paraplegic to ride so he can take his 13 year old son Made to school. Made was forced to drop out of school to look after his father when he was first injured. He was 9 years old.

Living on their own in a remote area in the foothills of Mt Agung, with no houses close by, now that Puspadi Bali have rehabilitated father Darma and have him using a wheelchair, Made can go back to school, if he has a way to get there.

A motor bike will not only allow Darma to take Made to school but will give him independence and allow him to again take his place in society. To go to the market & temple, maybe start a micro business and regain his pride as a father being able to look after his son.
